## Hawai'i Island School Garden Network Production Report: January 2008 to May 2010

Year 1: January -May 2008 (6 out of 18 gardens reporting)
Year 2: August 2008 - May 2009 (15 out of 30 gardens reporting)
Year 3: August 2009 - May 2010 (38 out of 56 gardens reporting)
I. Square footage has increased by 656,794 square feet or 15.1 acres; 2644\% increase

II. Production has increased 28,720 pounds or 14.4 tons; 6326\% increase.

III. Number of students involved in garden activities/instruction has increased from 883 to $\mathbf{3 8 5 0}$, an increase of $\mathbf{3 3 6 \%}$.
